The company implements standardized environmental management practices and strives to apply the best practices in the aviation sector. Finnair's environmental management system follows the principles of continuous improvement. The scope of the Finnair Environmental Management System covers flight operations, corporate buildings, catering functions, and aircraft maintenance services.

Finnair is committed to complying with environmental and energy efficiency regulation, and other applicable obligations while also anticipating developments in these fields.

Finnair acknowledges, continuously assesses, and responds to its environmental aspects and impacts.
