Finnair's environmental management system follows the principles of continuous improvement. The scope of the Finnair Environmental Management System covers flight operations, corporate buildings, catering functions, and aircraft maintenance services.

Finnair acknowledges, continuously assesses, and responds to its environmental aspects and impacts.
