Finnair Group (“Finnair”) connects Europe, North America, and Asia, bringing people, cultures, and economies together daily. As one of the world’s oldest continuously operating airlines, Finnair is committed to conducting sustainable business practices and improving its environmental performance both in its own operations and throughout its value chain.

Finnair’s most material environmental activities - flight operations, ground operations, and the use of materials and fuel - result primarily in emissions to air, resource use and waste. To ensure that society continues to benefit from the social and economic value of aviation, Finnair is committed to reducing its primary environmental impacts associated with flying while upholding strong social sustainability as a people-centred organisation.

Finnair is committed to managing these impacts by:

- **Regulatory compliance:** Finnair is committed to complying with environmental and energy efficiency regulation, and other applicable obligations while also anticipating developments in these fields.
- **Minimising the use of energy and materials and reducing dependence on fossil energy:** Finnair shall continuously improve its energy efficiency and enforce circular economy principles in its functions. Finnair shall pursue a transition away from fossil jet fuel, supported by cross-sector collaboration and informed by ongoing scientific and technological developments.
- **Carbon reduction:** Finnair is committed to the airline industry’s common goal of achieving net zero flying in 2050 and reducing its emission intensity in line with science-based target setting. In addition, the company is committed to having carbon neutral ground operations in its own operations (Scope 1 and 2) in the Helsinki-Vantaa Airport area.
- **Minimising pollution and protecting biodiversity:** Finnair is committed to protect the natural environment and striving to minimise release of waste and harmful substances to the environment. Finnair aims to protect biodiversity and ecosystems and aims to minimise its effect on those. The company shall not tolerate illegal wildlife trade and shall promote aviation industry’s activities against it.
- **Systematic approach, comprehensiveness and continuous improvement:** Finnair shall have an environmental management system in place, which addresses Finnair’s environmental and energy efficiency commitments and follows the principles of continuous improvement. Clearly defined objectives are set within the system to improve its performance. The company monitors, audits and reviews its performance, and collects and analyses data systematically on both its impacts on the environment and the external environmental and climate-related factors that might affect its operations. The scope of the Finnair Environmental Management System shall be assessed regularly, and currently covers network, traffic and fleet planning, flight operations, corporate buildings, catering functions and aircraft maintenance services.
- **Stakeholder engagement:** Finnair engages in an active and open dialogue with its stakeholders on environmental and energy efficiency issues relating to its operations, as well as on its goals and achievements. Together with its personnel and key external stakeholders Finnair proactively surveys the environmental concerns and viewpoints. Together with its partners, Finnair explores possibilities for the sustainable deployment of renewable energy and sustainable aviation fuels.
